No. Records. 77/68- R. 23 . For the performance of business in relation to the Director of Archives, the Governor of Bihar is pleased, under 166 and 309 of, and in exercise of other powers under the constitution of India to issue the following orders:-

- 2. The Director of Archives, Bihar will function as a head of department in sole charge of the State Central Records Office under the Administrative Control of the Political (General) Department.
- 3. The Director of Archives shall have all the powers under the various codes and rules which Heads of Departments ordinarily exercise.
- 4. Subject to observances of rules and procedure in force the Director of Archives shall have the power to appoint, dismiss or remove from service or otherwise punish all members of the subordinate service (Class III and IV) in the establishment of the State Central Records Office.
- 5. These order will come into force immediately.
